Cape Cod, the quintessential angler's home, with folks traveling here from around the world dreaming about catching a striped bass, blue fish, sharks, or pelagic quarry.

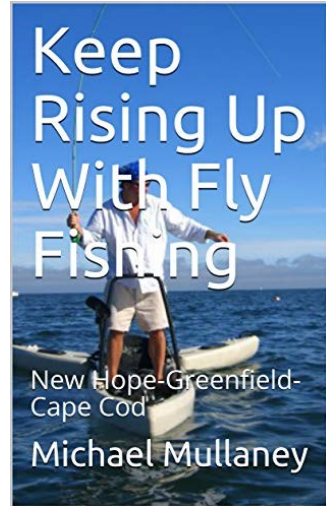

We encourage folks to choose to pursue the outer beaches on The Atlantic side, commonly referred to as The National Seashore as well as the inner bay side.

Eric explains “There are 3 harbors to the inner bay side that face west into the Bay; [Wellfleet](#), [Pamet](#), & [Provincetown](#). At Nauset there on the outer side, out to the east, an opening at the barrier beach to the Atlantic Ocean.”

Most of the fishing charters run the Bay towards the famous Billingsgate Shoals westward, or they head to the deeper canyon water at Stell-Wagon Bank.

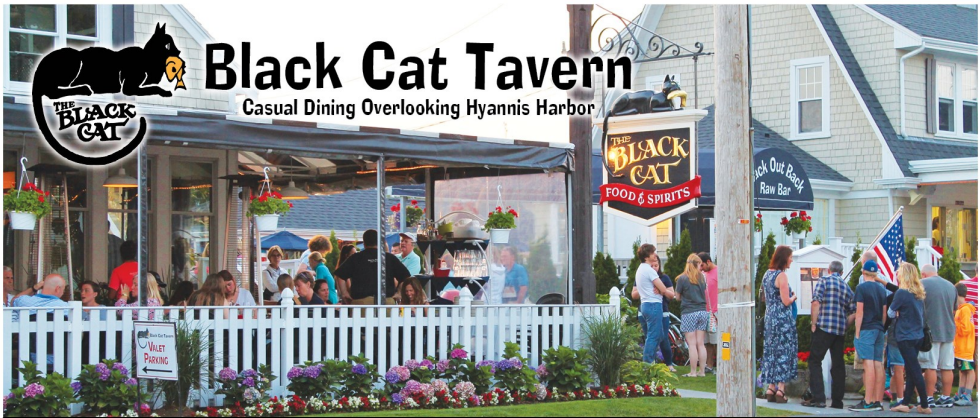
The Bay holds a myriad of species such as; whales, sharks, bluefish, cod, stripers, herring, & tuna.

On the open ocean side the stripers like to move up and down the coast in about 30 feet of water from Orleans north to The Race Point tip. Feeding on sand eels, anchovy, sea herring, crabs, lobsters, American eels, and menhaden. Atlantic shad can be seen on the Atlantic side, and of course the blue fin tuna as well.

Eric runs two different vessels. The first is a 24’ Hydra sports. And the second is a 28’ North Coast.

He has perfect access to all this blue water which includes rounding the point and checking out the water down the seacoast. Not to mention all the waters in and out of [Wellfleet Harbor](#), which is spectacular.

Fishing The Monomoy Rips

Jim explains how the fishery looks at the Island of Monomoy. Extending southward from the Cape's elbow. The north section forms just outside Stage Harbor. "It's very shallow on the inner Nantucket Sound side. The sands are in constant change.

"The rips form at the bottom of the Island as The Atlantic Ocean meets Nantucket Sound. "The cooler water meeting the warmer also produces a thermocline". bluebanditcharters@gmail.com

Starting at Saquatucket Harbor helping to provide a fast trip down to the shoals between Cape Cod & Nantucket Island.

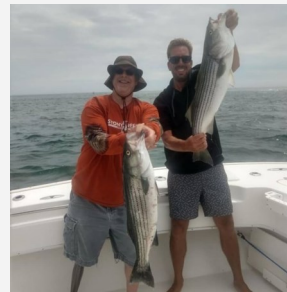
It takes a bout 1 hour from Harwichport depending on conditions.

The wind usually kicks up about 10am in the morning with the prevailing SW winder. “southwest” as they refer to it.

Hankerchief Shoals, is a famous reference point between the Island and The Port. And there are a series of buoy markers , as well that help define where and when the fish are landed. Out towards the canyons.

Many times the tuna and other pelagic species can run very close to the outer Chatham & Monomoy making for pure angler excitement!

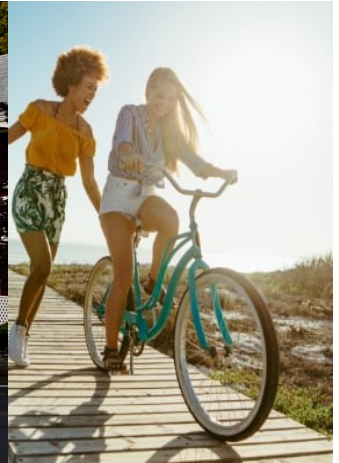

A Day in *Chatham!*

A day in Chatham would most likely start on the Nantucket Sound side at Stage Harbor. Heading in to the inlet , it breaks to the left up the Oyster River ,and to the right towards the Mill Pond. Great inshore action.

Tides advance up thru & under the Mitchell's River Bridge right up behind the Town scenic, small & quaint.

The new cut from The Atlantic feeds cold & fresh water past Morris Island. The tides roll in and **Outermost** making it's way into Pleasant Bay. The Bay is protected by a barrier beach showing off the ever changing sand bars. Heading up towards Orleans forming Nauset Beach.

The inner part of the Bay has **3 Islands**; **Tern, Strong, and Sipsons**.

Boaters can reach the Atlantic from several cuts. These are treacherous. The sand is constantly moving in this part of Cape Cod and over the years the openings to the Ocean has claimed many vessels.

Kayaking is a wonderful way to experience these waters. Especially in that both **Stage Harbor** & **Pleasant Bay** are protected from the open Ocean. Michael loves light tackle, fly fishing, & kayaking. He also works as a first mate on the center console boats with the other captains.

The cuts thru bring fresh ocean currents fresh full of baitfish & life.



Seamus prepares his trips in through fashion. Starting his journey before the sun rises and heads out of the harbor.

His tours take him around the tip of Monomoy and out into the Atlantic. Seamus's boat is named "Jail Break" and it is perfect for all types of fishing. Sharks, tuna, stripers, or blues.

Not to mention the hard to catch stuff like [Atlantic marlin](#), [swordfish](#), [mahi -mahi](#), [cod](#), & [more](#).

Seamus is a Hard working captain, loves his dog. The locals know him & respect his efforts. He's fun to be around. And with a name like "Seamus Muldoon" that may just speak for itself.

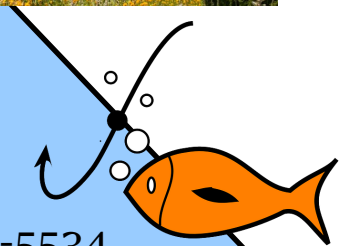
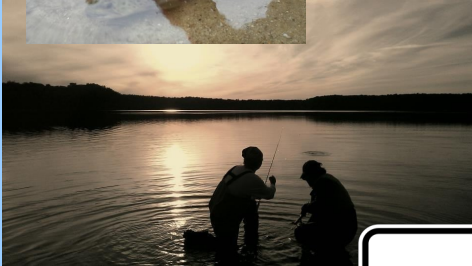
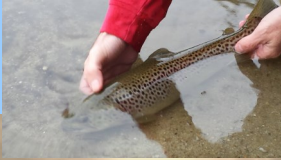

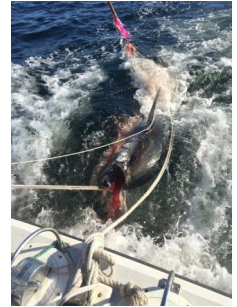
Wychmere Harbor

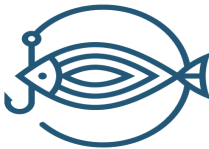

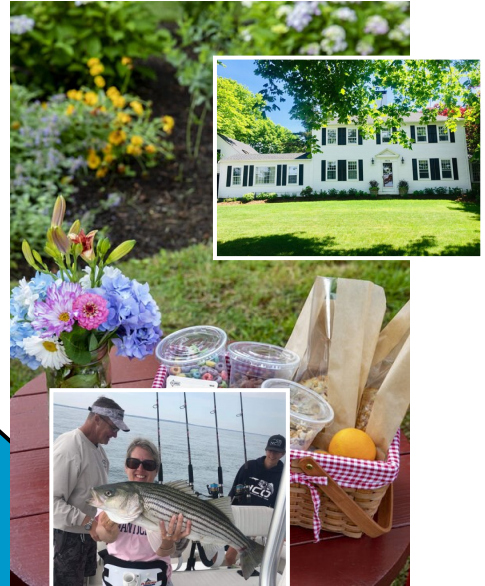

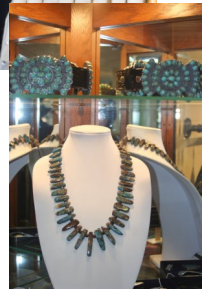

A fresh start in the morning might be having breakfast at the Sunny Side on Main Street.

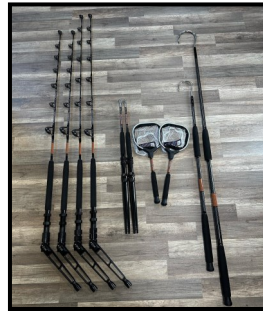
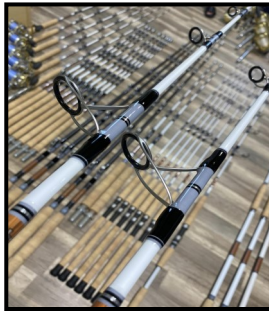

John explains that “Barnstable Village is one of the oldest towns in America. It’s history rides & ties in along route 6A with The Town of Sandwich. At [Millway Marina](#) the tide flows out into the main harbor and to The Cape Cod Bay telling a 300 year old story.”

A small harbor with a **wicked big** fishing heart, anglers can fish the entire Bay from this starting point. There is also a whale watching operation heading out to the Bay from this harbor. Home to the Millway town Beach, this water system holds lots of fishing potential. Great for kayaking & flat’s boat action.

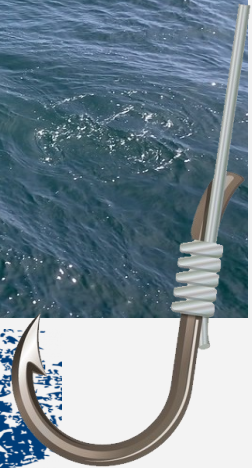
Capt. Carty's boat is named "The Lucky Lady" and has access out thru Barnstable Harbor. Entering the Cape Cod Bay can be exciting. Anglers pass the west and east chop just outside of the lighthouse. And the views from **Sandy Neck Beach** iconic!

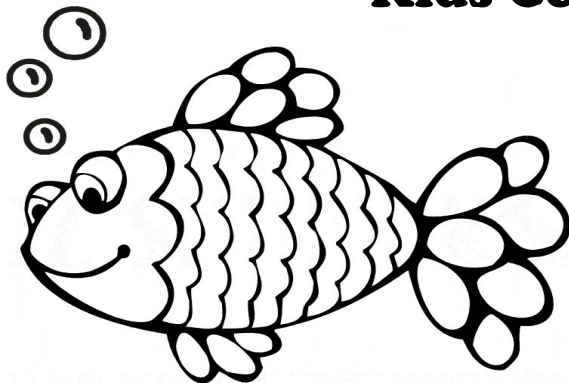

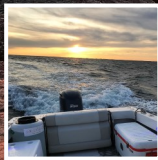

Fresh Water Pond Fishing

With Brewster Hardware

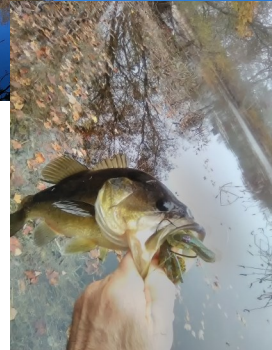


Chris Dudzik, manager at the hardware store on 6A in Brewster has assembled a very unique tackle section. The store specializes in fresh water tackle on Cape Cod.

Every town on Cape Cod holds several ponds. Anglers can pursue; [trout](#), [perch](#), [bass](#), & [pickerel](#).

The action starts in April and goes all the way thru November. Another interesting tid bit about Cape ponds many of them were formed by [glaciers](#), and are nice and deep. And they interact with the aquifers.

Along 6A from Dennis thru Brewster and into Orleans there are a series of ponds. And most notable is the Nickerson State Forest located just down the street from Brewster Hardware.

Noteworthy moments include each spring, the **herring run** in from the ocean to spawn in these ancient passages. Traveling up thru the marsh and up thru fish ladders they eventually reach their destination.

Many of the ponds are surrounded by cranberry bogs and fields. Making for great scenery.

Chris stocks; Hogey, Rapala, Yozuri, and other great products.

The team at Brewster Hardware also fish the Cape Cod Bay, which is minutes from the store. And they stock all sorts of salt water gear as well.

The Thomas Colorado spoons are fantastic choice for these waters and help catch all the various species.

The Sand Eel is a very popular Cape Cod Pattern, and used heavily on the Brewster Flats (Hogey Sand Eel)



Flats Style Fishing

With Capt. John Curry



In John's words "sight fishing for Striped Bass on The Cape's crystal-clear shallow flats is legendary. Seeing a school of fish cruising towards the boat builds angling excitement. That perfect cast with either a fly or small jig will with the anticipation of landing the fish of a lifetime gets the heart pounding."

John lives in the Pocasset area. He guides on most of the Upper and Mid Cape and launches from various ramps on Buzzards Bay, Falmouth and the Elizabeth Islands as well as Barnstable Harbor to name a few.

The stripers travel up the Eastern seaboard in the summer on the journey to New England and many of these fish come right up the canal. Also the town of Falmouth, and in and around that entire coastline is a series of harbors that the stripers love to enter. The stripers are chasing ; squid, menhaden, anchovy silversides, sand eels, and herring. There even is a herring run right on the canal.

Just south of the Bay is the Island of Martha's Vineyard. And both the Elizabeth Islands and Block Island. All of these areas hold keeper stripers.

Over the past decade mackerel have decided to hang out in the canal. From the East End(kind of looks north on the map) to the west end (yes, it actually goes to the west before meeting with the bay). When the bait stays in that area the entire summer, why would you want to fish anywhere else?

The grey ghost can travel, and Capt. John also loves to flat's fish at Barnstable Harbor, The Brewster Flat's or Scorton's Ledge. Capt. Curry holds a USCG Master license and is fully insured.

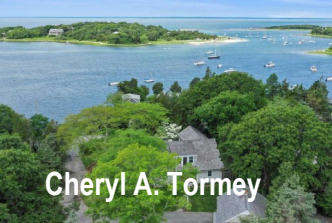
The Cheeky Schoolie tournament, slated for its 12th annual striped bass tournament on May 20th, raises significant funds for striped bass conservation groups including Stripers Forever, Keep Fish Wet and the American Saltwater Guides Association. The tournament, held each spring on Cape Cod, is the largest fly-fishing tournament in the world and is adamantly catch and release. With all the proceeds going to conservation, last year the tournament donated more than \$28,000. With teams being disqualified if fish are not photographed at the waterline, this year the Schoolie is working on some angler research with UMASS researchers to do a massive catch and release study during the tournament.

"The Tournament is about fun, bringing some business to the cape, and above all, the fish," said Peter Vandergrift of Cheeky Fishing.

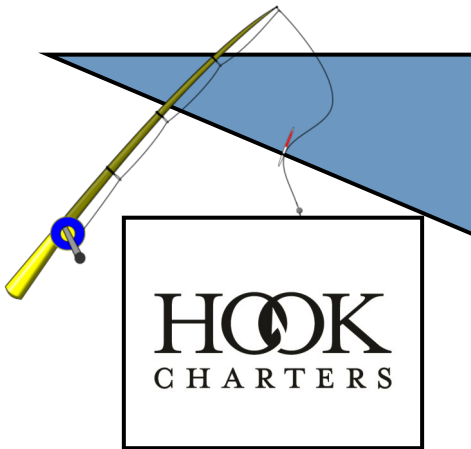

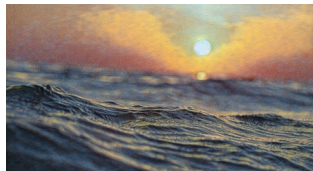

The Capt. Farris House



Built in 1845 by a wealthy sea captain, the historic [Captain Farris House](#) has been restored to incorporate luxurious, modern [amenities](#) while preserving its distinctive Greek Revival style architecture. The result is a picturesque B&B featuring ten inviting rooms, an elegant dining room, a lovely parlor, and stunning gardens.

This heritage site and property built in the 1850's; highlights the era of Capt. Crowell his family. Today it is a Living History Museum. Crowell Homestead is one of the few remaining original Sea Captains Properties on Sea Captains Row that today tells a more complete story of these homes.

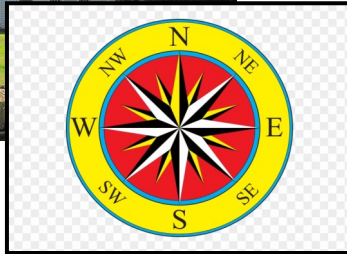

The Capt. Shubael Baxter House



The house was built c. 1829 by Captain Shubael Baxter, it was a more conventional Federal style structure, five bays wide. Later owners include another ship captain and a surgeon who served in the [American Civil War](#). The Colonial Revival alterations, which included extending the width by two bays and construction of the portico, are attributed to J. S. Trombley, who is recorded



While its basic form is that of a Federal-style Cape, it was altered in the late 19th century, adding a shed-roof dormer with an eyebrow section, a porch with turned posts, and a projecting window bay. In the mid-19th century the house belonged to William Hallett, a ship's captain, and around the turn of the 20th century by Dr. Charles Harris, a noted local physician and author of *Hyannis Sea Captains*.^[2]
